2010 Lamb Show Rules and Regulations

1. This show is open to all 4-H and FFA members who are between entering the First grade and entering the 12th grade and not over the age of 19.
2. Certificates of veterinary inspection are required and must state that the animals are “free from foot rot, scabies contagious exthyma, cutaneous fungal disease.” All ewe lambs must have a USDA scrapie tag.
3. All animals, wethers or ewes, will be shown as market animals and slick shorn. All animals must be bedded in the show barn. Pens will not be altered (i.e. no wind tunnels).
4. Pre-registered entries will be \$10 per head per show. All entries postmarked after **August 1st, 2010** will be considered late entries and will be charged a late fee of \$20 per head.
5. Showmanship exhibitors will show in individual classes as 1st grade through 12th grade. Class will be the grade the exhibitor will be in this fall. Preschool showmanship will follow selection of Champion Showmanship. Belt buckle will be awarded to Champion Showman overall.
6. Lambs will be weighed in between 7:00 and 8:30 am on Saturday, August 21st. After the lamb leaves the scales, there will be no re-weighs. There will be no weight cards or weigh backs. Verify your weight before leaving scale area.
7. Lambs will be shown by weight. There will be 4 divisions with a champion and reserve in each division in the B&B Summer Classic. Division Champions will not be selected in the Bulldawg Bonanza show.
8. Only registered exhibitors actively showing lambs and show officials will be allowed in the show arena, except in the preschool showmanship class.
9. Exhibitors must show their own lambs unless otherwise approved by Block and Bridle Show Committee. If an exhibitor has 2 lambs in one class, another show exhibitor may show one of the lambs.
10. Preschool exhibitors may borrow any lamb for the showmanship competition.
11. The Block and Bridle Summer Classic Lamb Show Committee reserves the right to review these rules and make changes if necessary. All decisions made by the Show Committee are final.
12. **Free bedding will be in the pens when you arrive.**
13. Premiums will not be paid in class, however awards will be presented to Division winners and Champions Overall.
14. In the Bulldawg Bonanza the top five in each class will receive a check when leaving the showing. Premium will also be paid to Grand and Reserve Champion Overall.
